

INFORMATION ABOUT THE PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING OF LEGAL PEOPLE BY THE OCALENIE FOUNDATION

In accordance with the European Parliament and EU Council Directive 2016/679 of April 27th 2016 on the subject of protection of the personal data of the legal persons and on the subject of freedom of data flow, as well as the cancelation of the directive 95/46/WE (general directive concerning personal data, „RODO“).

Data Administrator is the Ocalenie Foundation with its office in Warsaw, 00-537, at st. Kruczej 6/14a. NIP: 118-157-02-03; KRS: 0000030279; REGON: 016446315, represented by the Management.

Legal basis for the data processing is the realization of tasks in the public interest that result from the Ocalenie Foundation's regulations (art. 6 ust. 1 lit.e. RODO).

Personal data provided will be processed with a goal of recruiting volunteers in helping Ukrainian refugees.

The personal data can be shared to the third party only in terms of realizing the goals described in point 3. The receivers of the data can be:

- workers entrusted by the Administrator;
- service providers, who've been entrusted via formal agreements to process Personal Data in terms of providing their services for the Administrator - only to a degree essential to provide the service;
- authorities entrusted to receive personal data via law regulations.

The owner of the personal data has a right to:

- demand from the Administrator to access, correct, delete the data or limit its processing;
- file an appeal to the processing;
- move the data;
- file a complaint to the supervisory authority.

Personal data will be processed throughout the recruitment for volunteering in helping Ukrainian refugees. Personal data of those candidates who did not qualify, will be kept for 12 months after the recruitment process, in case of potential complaints and the reservation list processing.

Personal data is not used for automatized decision-making, including profiling.
