



**Terms and Conditions for making donations on the websites ocalenie.org.pl,
witajwdomu.org.pl, and refugeeswelcome.pl**

I. Preliminary Provisions

1. These Terms and Conditions define the rules for the provision of services by the Ocalenie Foundation, based in Warsaw, 00-357, at ul. Krucza 6/14A, NIP: 118-157-02-03, KRS: 0000030279, REGON: 016446315, hereinafter referred to as the Foundation. The service is provided electronically and enables persons using websites in the domain crm.ocalenie.org.pl to make monetary donations for the Foundation's statutory activities.
2. Whenever these Terms and Conditions refer to the websites ocalenie.org.pl, witajwdomu.org.pl, and refugeeswelcome.pl, it shall be understood as any of their subpages in the domain crm.ocalenie.org.pl that enable payments.
3. Whenever these Terms and Conditions refer to the Donor, it shall be understood as any person using ocalenie.org.pl, witajwdomu.org.pl and refugeeswelcome.pl websites to make a donation.
4. By using the donation website, the Donor declares and confirms that they have read and accepted the provisions of these Terms and Conditions.
5. The current version of the Terms and Conditions is always available to Donors on the ocalenie.org.pl website.

II. Rules for making donations on the website

1. Donations transferred by Donors are used exclusively for activities consistent with the statutory goals of the Foundation. By transferring financial resources, Donors make a donation within the meaning of Art. 888 § 1 of the Polish Civil Code. Making a transfer of financial resources results in fulfilling the premises of Art. 890 § 1 sentence two of the Polish Civil Code, which means that regardless of the



failure to maintain the form of a notarial deed, the donation is valid and effective regardless of the form in which the statements of the Parties were made.

2. A donation can be transferred after completing the data and clicking "WPŁAĆ" / "WSPIERAM" on pages in the domain crm.ocalenie.org.pl. After clicking the link, one should follow the instructions provided on the website of the payment operator.
3. Transferring donations on pages in the domain crm.ocalenie.org.pl takes place via payment operators:

4. A donation can be made using an electronic transfer, a payment card (credit or debit), and the BLIK mobile payment system.
5. Payments of Donors are protected by a secure SSL certificate. Thanks to it, all transmitted information is encrypted.
6. Via the website, one can transfer one-time donations or recurring donations, enabling the regular, monthly transfer of a declared monetary amount from an indicated payment card to the Foundation.
7. When transferring a donation, the Donor can choose one of the amounts suggested on the pages in the domain crm.ocalenie.org.pl or enter any amount of their choice in the "Inna" field.

III. Tax exemptions

Ocalenie Foundation is a public benefit organization. In accordance with the provisions of law, Art. 26 para. 1 point 9 of the Act on Personal Income Tax, there is a possibility to deduct the value of transferred donations from income in the tax year. Donations transferred for the activities of the Foundation can be deducted from income: a natural person up to an



amount equal to 6% of income before taxation (Art. 26 para. 1 point 9 of the Act on Personal Income Tax), a legal person up to an amount equal to 10% of income before taxation (Art. 18 para. 1 point 1 and 7 of the Act on Corporate Income Tax). Confirmation of the transfer should be kept for 5 years from making the donation.

IV. Regular donations in the form of recurring payments

1. By choosing to make a recurring donation, the Donor authorizes the Payment Operator to automatically deduct a monthly amount from their payment card, equal to the specific donation value selected or manually entered by the Donor.
2. A recurring donation will be collected by the Payment Operator once a month..
3. The Donor, within the recurring payment service, has the possibility to save card data and order a standing payment order. Card data are stored by the payment operator. The payment operator, mediating in the payment, provides a Token for recurring payments (a virtual card identifier), enabling the assignment of a unique identifier to an individual Donor, by means of which the Donor periodically makes payments to the Foundation.
4. The Foundation does not collect and does not process in its IT system data from payment cards (credit or debit) of Donors. The Donor provides this data exclusively to Payment Operators.
5. Data of the Donor, title, and the amount of the payment are delivered to the Payment Operator by the Foundation. The order is transferred for registration after the Payment Operator receives the payment.
6. The Payment Operator does not collect a fee from the Donor for the service. The entire amount of the donation goes to the Foundation's account. The Payment Operator collects a commission and additional fees from the Foundation.
7. In the case of a lack of funds on the account or a too low authorization limit, the declared amount will not be collected.
8. On the day the validity of the Donor's card expires, the charging of the card will cease and donations will not be collected. Subsequent



donations can be provided by the Donor after renewing the card and re-establishing a regular payment on the ocalenie.org.pl website using the new card.

VI. Complaints, resignation from recurring payments, returns of donations, complaints of services

1. In the event of problems with transferring a one-time or recurring donation, they should be reported to the Foundation at the address: biuro@ocalenie.org.pl.
2. The Donor may submit a complaint directly to the Payment Operator if the services provided for in the regulations of the Payment Operator have not been provided or are provided inconsistently with its provisions.
3. A recurring payment can be cancelled by the Donor at any time by contacting the Foundation at the address: anulowanie-wplaty@ocalenie.org.pl. Please place the words: „Rezygnacja z darowizny” in the subject of the message, and in the content include information such as: name and surname, e-mail address that was provided in the declaration of joining recurring payments. The payment will be cancelled from the month following the month in which the Donor reported the cancellation.
